





# Five C's of Credit



- Character The "Financial Reputation" of the business, credit history, and management experience.
- Capacity Measures the ability to repay, financial strength, and cash flow.
- Capital Owner's equity and financial commitment to the company.
- Collateral Assets pledged to secure the loan (equipment, real estate, inventory, etc.)
- ► Conditions The loan interest rate, term (duration³), and purpose.



# Loan Approval, Funding, & Payments

- Completed application / project meets the 5 C's
- Loan Committee
- ▶ RFA for funding approval
- Escrow account for signing loan documents and disbursements
- UCC's to secure collateral
- Collect and monitor monthly loan payments
- Annual compliance of loan portfolio
