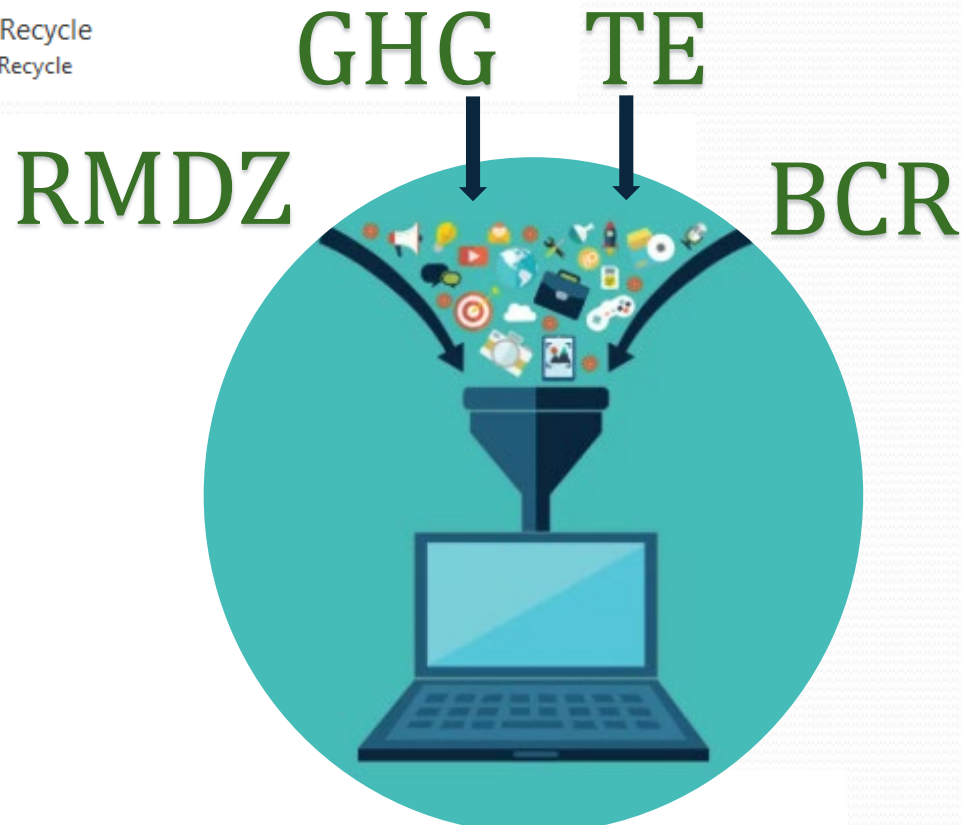

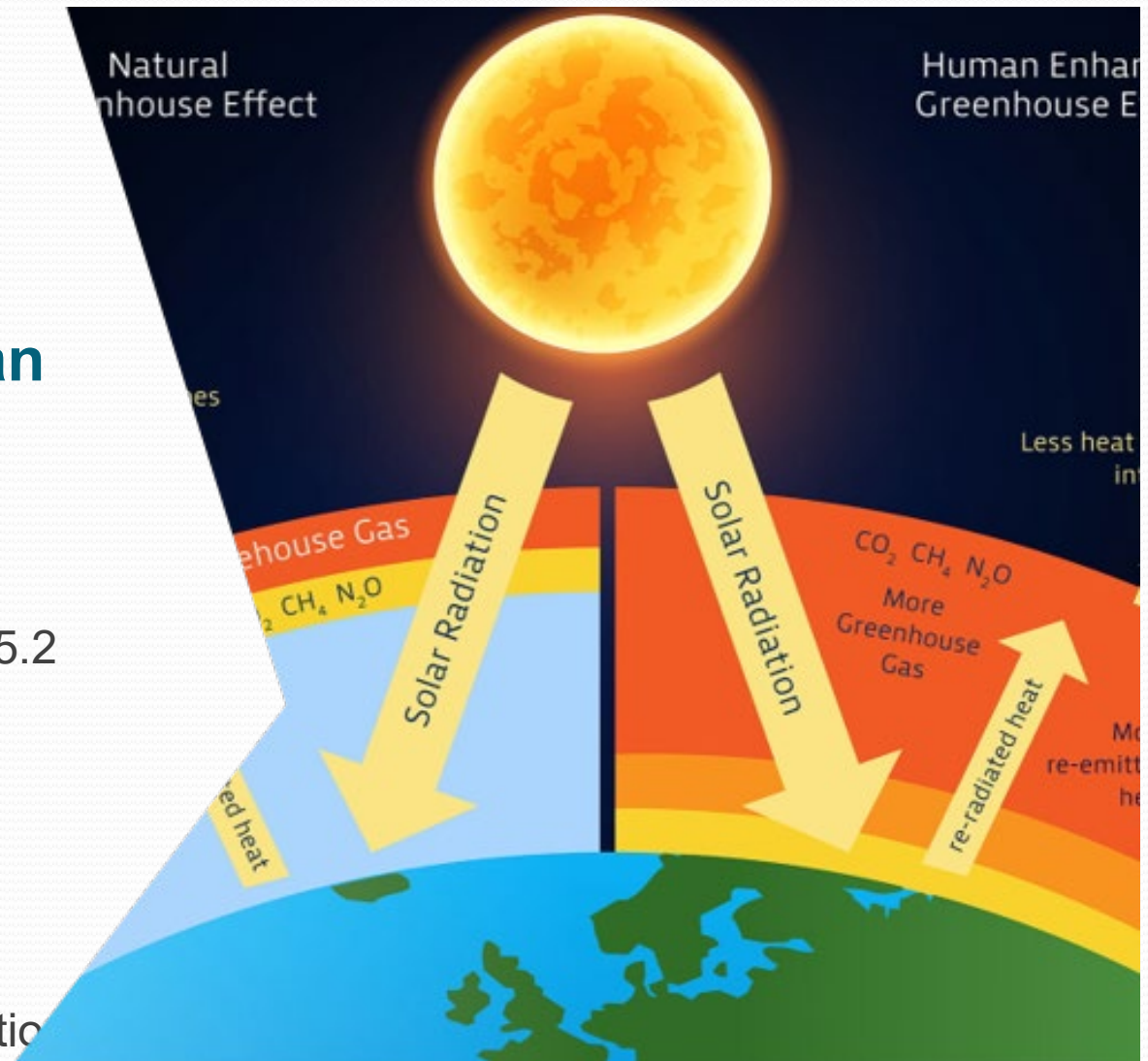

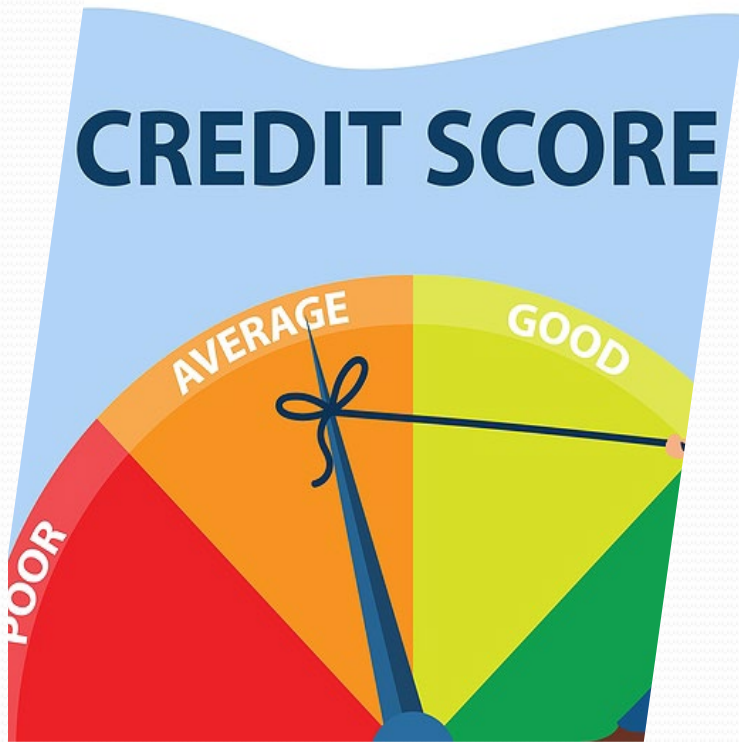

Five C's of Credit



- ▶ Character - The "Financial Reputation" of the business, credit history, and management experience.
- ▶ Capacity – Measures the ability to repay, financial strength, and cash flow.
- ▶ Capital – Owner's equity and financial commitment to the company.
- ▶ Collateral – Assets pledged to secure the loan (equipment, real estate, inventory, etc.)
- ▶ Conditions – The loan interest rate, term (duration)¹³, and purpose.



Loan Approval, Funding, & Payments

- ▶ Completed application / project meets the 5 C's
- ▶ Loan Committee
- ▶ RFA for funding approval
- ▶ Escrow account for signing loan documents and disbursements
- ▶ UCC's to secure collateral
- ▶ Collect and monitor monthly loan payments
- ▶ Annual compliance of loan portfolio
